This FT role requires the right individual(s) to work in a team setting on large commercial glazing projects. He/she will perform commercial installation specializing in: interior walls and partitions, curtain wall, aluminum storefronts, commercial windows systems and sealed units.

Reports to: Site Foreman

Hours: Generally 40 hrs. /week, Monday to Friday, occasional OT to meet deadlines

Duties:

- Measure and mark glass and cut glass using glass cutting equipment/tools;
- Position glass panes into frames and secure glass using clips, points or moldings
- Assemble and install prefabricated glass or glass products on walls, ceilings or exteriors of building
- Install, fit, fabricate and attach architectural metals or related substitute products in commercial and residential buildings
- Prepare and install skylights and other special glass in commercial and institutional establishments
- Repair and service commercial aluminum doors and other glass supporting structures, and replace damaged glass or faulty sealant
- Assemble, erect and dismantle scaffolds, rigging and hoisting equipment
- Read and interpret blueprints and specifications to determine type and thickness of glass, frame, installation procedure and materials required

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Presently enrolled or wanting to enroll in the four year apprenticeship glazing program from a recognized institution or have earned their Journeyman ticket
 - Aptitude with math, measuring, and use of hand and power tools
 - Some blue print reading
 - Preference to those with a valid Alberta Class 5 driver's license
 - Physically fit to be able to perform within the working conditions
 - Fluent reading, writing and speaking in English
 - Legally able to work in Canada
